Please read carefully

- The prose or poetry piece was written by student without any assistance by adult or teacher.
- 2. The choice of topic is entirely free. The aim is to encourage creative writing on any subject.
- 3. The entry submitted should not exceed 1000 words.
- 4. All entries must be typed and submitted as a Word Document.
- 5. Each entry must be accompanied by a clearly marked entry stating the student's year level and section (Prose or Poetry).
- 6. The declaration form testifying the authenticity of the work must accompany the piece.
